## Woodberry Kitchen to open in Clipper Mill, apply for liquor license

Woodberry Kitchen is opening their doors in Clipper Mill at 2010 Clipper Mill Rd. The restaurant will be run by Spike and Amy Gjerde (From Spike & Charlie's restaurant), along with owner Nelson Carey, who owns Grand Cru. Woodberry Kitchen will be doing a "Farm to table" approach to running their restaurant with organic meats and seasonal crops from local farmers.

Woodberry Kitchen is also applying for a Class "B" Restaurant beer, wine, and liquor license. If approved, it would be the first liquor license in Woodberry since its creation. Traditionally, Woodberry has been a dry community, with no liquor

licenses, unlike most of Baltimore City. The hearing for their liquor license application is on Aug. 2<sup>nd</sup> at 2:45pm at City Hall in room 215. Write the liquor board or come out in favor or opposition to their application.

Woodberry Kitchen's entrees will range from \$9 for a hamburger or shell beans & rice to \$22 & \$25 for a strip steak or Smith Island crab cake.
